

Népszabadság was a liberal left Hungarian newspaper. It was founded in 1956 and was part of the Hungarian Socialist Worker's Party. After 1989 it was still closely aligned to them. End of 2016 Népszabadság, the leading opposition medium, was closed down surprisingly.

According to the owners, the losses were too high. According to editors, however, the closure was politically motivated.
